Lincoln Cathedral is a Grade 1 Listed Building. It is situated in a Conservation Area and areas of the Close are a Scheduled Ancient Monument. The area is an undesignated heritage asset and is archaeologically sensitive.

The project will transform the Close into a variety of public places, creating a distinct area within the wider cityscape and opening up parts of the Close which are currently closed to the public.
