New Design Museum

Design Museum plans to create the world's leading museum of contemporary design and architecture at the former Commonwealth Institute in Kensington.

John Pawson has redesigned the interior of the former Commonwealth Institute, a Grade II*-listed building which has lain dormant for over a decade. The move will give the Design Museum three times more space in which to show a wider range of exhibitions, showcase its world class collection and extend its learning programme. The move will bring the museum into Kensington's cultural quarter where it will join the V&A, Science Museum, Natural History Museum, Royal College of Art and Serpentine Gallery.
