The existing museum collection is housed within an old residential building converted into the museum but with a very limiting layout of small rooms connected by narrow corridors on various levels. The collection has far outgrown its current location both in terms of exhibition and storage. The new museum will provide state of the art education facilities, full fitted storage and archive rooms (accessible to the public by appointment) a single coherent display space, temporary exhibition gallery, café and staff offices.
